


BDP R6G tetrazine

BDP R6G is a borondipyrromethene dye that has absorption and emission wavelengths close to rhodamine 6G (R6G). BDP R6G is a very bright and photostable dye.

Tetrazine fragment is used in inverse electron demand Diels Alder reaction with trans-cyclooctenes, acylazetines, and other strained olefins.
